RULES OF EQUESTRIAN



Equestrian sport under the guidance of the Federation Equestre Internationale (FEI)

The FEI (Fédération Équestre Internationale), the governing body of Equestrian sport oversee several disciplines, including Dressage, Jumping, Eventing, Endurance, Reining, Driving, and Vaulting. Of these, Dressage, Jumping, and Eventing are the three disciplines included in the Olympic.

Equestrian disciplines registered with Thailand Equestrian Federation:

- Dressage
- Jumping
- Eventing
- Endurance.

In the recent year, another two disciplines had been registered under TEF including Cowboy and Reining, creating more diversity among Equestrian realm in Thailand.





DRESSAGE

Known as the ballet of equestrian, Dressage athlete must precisely guide their horse through a predetermined sequence of movements, or known in other word as 'Test,' which they receive beforehand. This Test typically involves various changes in pace and smooth transitions, including collected movements within the arena. Riders are scored by judges from 0 to 10 for how accurately they perform each element. The competitor with the highest total score wins the medal.

PARA-DRESSAGE

ENDURANCE

Endurance riding, often called the 'equestrian marathon,' is a long-distance competition against the clock across natural landscapes and varied terrain. Originated in the United States, it became a competitive sport in the 1950s. Success in Endurance requires immense physical fitness and mental toughness from both the horse and the rider.

EVENTING

Eventing is a demanding sport that tests the versatility of the horse and rider partnership. It is comprised of three phases: Dressage, Cross-Country, and Jumping. Eventing usually takes three days, progressing from the finesse of Dressage on day one, to the stamina of Cross-Country on day two, and wrapping up with the precision of the Jumping phase on the final day, truly an equestrian triathlon.

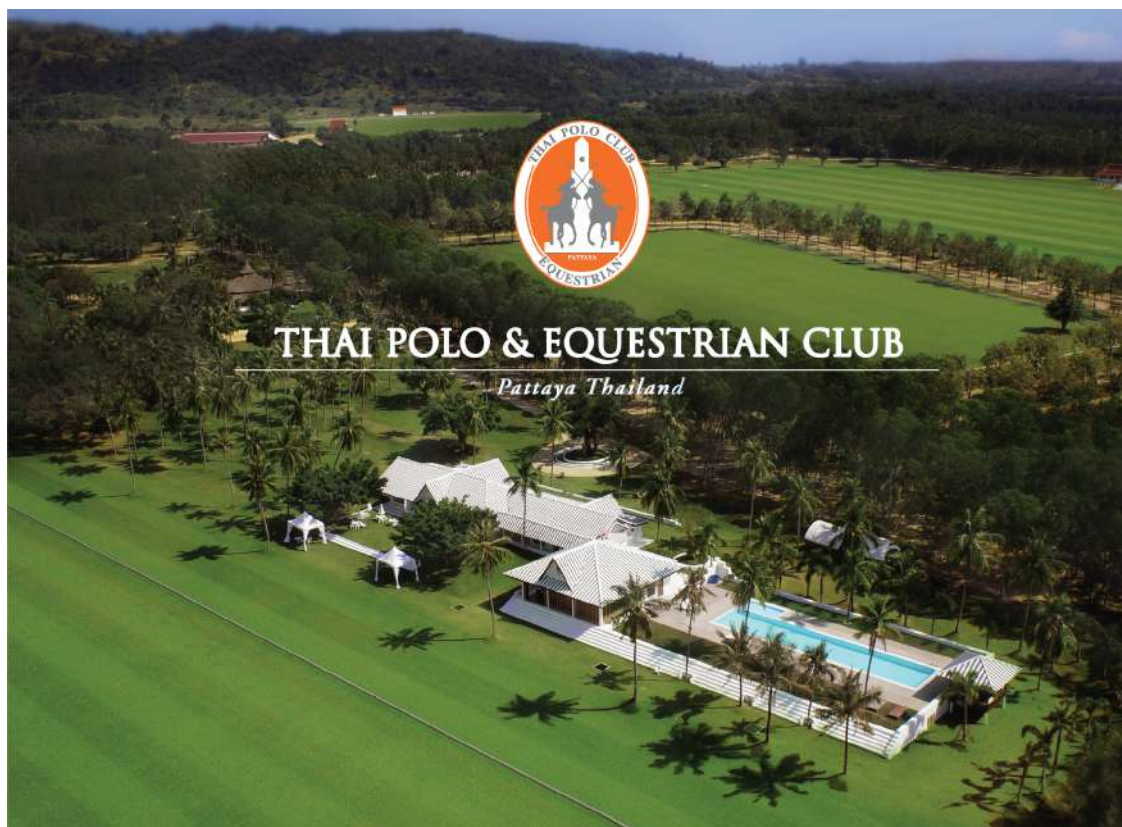

With its stunning natural setting of open fields, wooded hills and lakes, Thai Polo has become a home for riders and players from around the world who train and compete here throughout the season.

Thai Polo & Equestrian Club holds a special place in Asian equestrian history as the host of the first-ever FEI Asian Championships, staged in 2019. The success of this landmark event established Thailand as a trusted and capable equestrian destination, demonstrating the club's commitment to excellence, professionalism and world-class competition management.

Over the years, the club has continued to grow as a hub for international sporting exchange.
